The radio is considered to be leased and will be maintained, replaced in event of failure and upgraded from co-op revenue at no future additional cost to the member.

On termination of membership the radio will be returned to the co-op and the \$150 lease fee refunded.

Other equipment includes up to 30m of outdoor Cat5 cable, radio mount, wall jack and a wireless router. The co-op will maintain the wireless router as long as the original configuration is not changed.

Installations requiring more than 30m of cable, radios mounted above easy reach or other complications may cost more. These costs will be the responsibility of the new co-op member.

Infrastructure cost covers a share in the cost and maintenance of the backbone repeaters required to distribute the service.

Installation labour cost in the schedule above is for a simple installation (most will be in this category).

A site survey and estimate of installation costs will be completed prior to all new installations. The site survey and estimated costs will include any additional labour cost expected for more complicated installations.

Monthly cost for full time high-speed service .....\$60. + HST = \$67.20
